

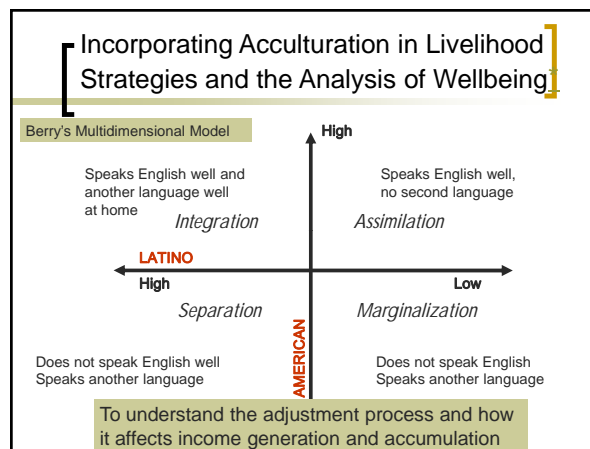
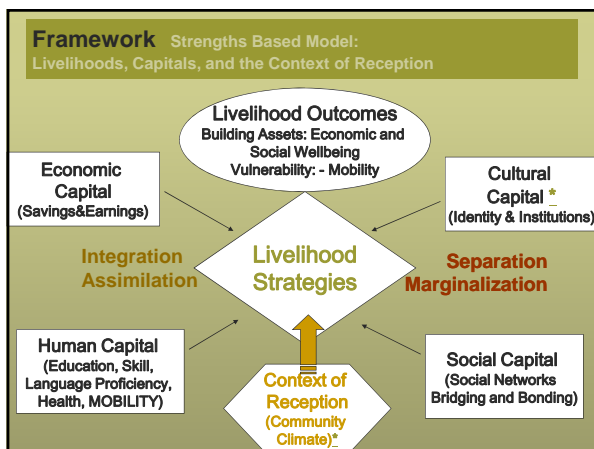

- What effects do Mobility, Acculturation and Community Climate have on Income and Wellbeing?



Findings from a quantitative analysis

Effect of Mobility, Acculturation and Climate on Income of Latinos (Valdivia et al 2008)

Variables	Origin	
	Natives	Foreign
Work Experience	0.293	0.202
Acculturation-integration	+ 0.280	+ 0.137
Acculturation-assimilation	0.024#	+ 0.042
Racial profiling	-0.046	-0.081
Gender: Female	-0.174	-0.512
Mobility	0.022 #	-0.018
Social Capital index	0.174	0.074

Not significant
-Three regions of Missouri, Census and AG data 2000

Findings from Asset Accumulation Project

258 Households
Two regions (North and Central)

My life is close to my ideal	4.71 (0.1)	4.75 (.2)	4.69 (.1)
Conditions of my life are excellent	4.96 (.1)	5.04 (.2)	4.93 (.1)
Are satisfied with my life	5.59 (.1)	5.61 (.2)	5.58 (.1)
So far I have gotten the important things in my life **	4.97 (.1)	4.95 (.2)	5.03 (.1)
If I could live forever I would change almost nothing	4.26 (.1)	4.41 (.3)	4.24 (.2)

Acculturation

Categories	Total	Integration	Separation
Spanish Mean of 12	3.4	3.5	3.4
English Mean of 12	1.9	3.1	1.6

SCALE 1 - 4

Acculturation Groups

Top-Left (Integration): N = 53 ; 21%. English (mean) > 2.5, Spanish (mean) > 2.5.

Top-Right (Assimilation): N = 3 ; 1%. English (mean) > 2.5, Spanish (mean) < 2.5.

Bottom-Left (Separation): N = 192 ; 74%. English (mean) < 2.5, Spanish (mean) > 2.5.

Bottom-Right (Marginalization): N = 6 ; 2%. English (mean) < 2.5, Spanish (mean) < 2.5.

Community Climate & the Context of Reception

Three groups of items measure context of reception

- Social Cultural Environmental 12 items
- Racism & Discrimination Stresses 8 items
- Language 5 items

Climate & Context of Reception: Social Cultural Environment

4 is neutral

Scores > 4 Negative Context of Reception

Climate & Context of Reception: Racism & Discrimination

My appearance makes it hard to fit in the community	3.6	NS	
People in this community have stereotypes about my culture P<.1	4.4	3.9	4.6
I have been treated rudely or unfairly because I am a newcomer	3.0	NS	
I have been discriminated against because I am a newcomer	3.0	NS	
People expect me to behave in a certain way because of my race and ethnicity	3.7	NS

7 strongly agree

Scores > 4 Negative Context of Reception

Climate & Context of Reception: Language

QUESTIONS (7)	4.4	Int	Sep
I feel pressured to learn English	5.4	4.5	5.6
My language makes it hard to fit into this community	4.5	2.7	5.7
Since I don't speak English well people have treated me rudely or unfairly	3.3	2.8	5.0
I have been discriminated against because I have difficulty speaking English (P<.1)	3.4	2.9	3.5
I bothers me that I speak English with an accent (P<.1)	3.6	2.9	3.8
I feel uncomfortable being around people who only speak English	3.8	NS	

Scores > than 4 = Negative Context of Reception
